

SCHOOL NURSE REMINDERS

Lauderdale County School System has a policy for children being sent home from school with illness. To help prevent the spread of certain viruses, we are requiring that your child stay home for 24 hours after being sent home from school:

- Vomiting more than once within the last 24 hours.
- Fever greater than 100.5F within the last 24 hours. (without Tylenol/Motrin).
- Diarrhea more than once within the last 24 hours.
- Head colds with continuous cough that produces gagging/spit up.
- Eye(s) that are matted shut, red, or have drainage/excessive tearing.
- Open sores/ areas that have redness or drainage.

These are conditions that are or maybe contagious. When students come to school sick they infect all those that they come in contact with throughout the day. Parents will be called to pick up students who exhibit the symptoms listed above. Your cooperation in this matter will be greatly appreciated.
